



Overview

The **University of Alberta Museums** is pleased to offer a summer internship opportunity to be awarded to a student currently enrolled at the senior undergraduate level at the University of Alberta.

The successful applicant will undertake a summer internship, up to four months in length, with the University of Alberta Museums unit gaining a diverse experience in museum practice in a research intensive, object-based learning environment. The student will undertake projects in one or more of the following areas of museology/museum innovation:

- **Community Engagement:** formal/informal approaches to learning and engagement which are of benefit to the community. Opportunities include: public and educational programs, contributing content for the web/social media, event planning and implementation.
- **Conservation:** preventive projects including mount-making, artifact preparation.
- **Curation:** collections-based research resulting in new knowledge (e.g., researching objects; research for exhibition projects, writing didactic and interpretive materials).
- **Exhibitions/Design:** exhibition planning, design, installation and considerations for the presentation, care, interpretation of museum objects.
- **Information/Collections Management:** database projects, online access and digitization, collections management processes related to registration, cataloguing, inventory, loans, deaccessioning.
- **Research:** exploring ideas/theories related to museum innovation, the future of museums and their role in the world.

Who can apply?

We are looking for a creative thinker who is passionate about working in the museum field in the future and who will bring an innovative approach to the internship. To be eligible, the following requirements must be met:

- Students who are currently registered in a University of Alberta undergraduate program in a collections-based discipline, with an interest in object-based learning.
- Students who have completed at least three years (minimum *80 credits) towards an undergraduate degree at the University of Alberta prior to starting the internship.
- Students who have completed *120 credits within the past academic year are also eligible.
- Students who are in good academic standing (at least a 3.0 GPA in the most recent 30 credits is recommended).

- Students who are legally permitted to work in Canada.
- Students who have demonstrated an interest in museums through volunteer or work experience.

How to Apply

Interested applicants are invited to attend one of two information sessions about the internship program and how to apply. These information sessions will be held on:

Thursday, January 26, 2023 at 4:30 p.m. (presented online via Zoom) **and**
Wednesday, February 15, 2023 at 12:00 p.m. (presented in-person at 3-20 Rutherford South)

Applications **must include** the following:

- a completed University of Alberta Museums Student Internship in Museum Innovation **application form** (Page 5 & 6 of this package)
- a **curriculum vitae**
- an up-to-date University of Alberta **transcript** (can be unofficial)
- a maximum two-page (750 word) **statement of interest** that identifies a specific area(s) of interest in museology/museum innovation and demonstrates:
 - the applicant's passion and interest in a museum career, outlining relevant museum-related work and/or volunteer experience;
 - the applicant's interest in areas of museum practice and museum collections; and
 - how the internship supports the applicant's short-term and long-term education and professional goals.
- **two (2) letters of support** that address:
 - the nature and specifics of the referee's relationship to the applicant;
 - an overview of the applicant's education and/or professional experience;
 - the referee's assessment of the applicant's prospects for success in the internship program;
 - the referee's assessment of the applicant's interest and suitability for a museum/ museology related professional career; and
 - any academic and/or professional accomplishments with which the referee is familiar.

- Applications will be adjudicated by March 31, 2023 in accordance with University of Alberta human resource protocols.
- The internship is offered annually between May and August and will begin and conclude at mutually agreeable dates negotiated between the successful applicant and the University of Alberta Museums unit. Interns will be employed by the University of Alberta Museums unit.
- Remuneration: Grade 3 Step 1 (Operating Trust | 35 hours/week).
